

A'Maze

Finished Quilt Size: 52 by 68 inches
 Finished Block Size: 14 inches square and 14 by 26
 Arrange blocks 3 by 3 – total of 9 blocks

Kit Requirements

.6 M Theme Panel
 .75 M Frame 1
 .75 M Frame 2
 1 M Outer Border
 .5 M Binding

Minimum Fabric Yardage

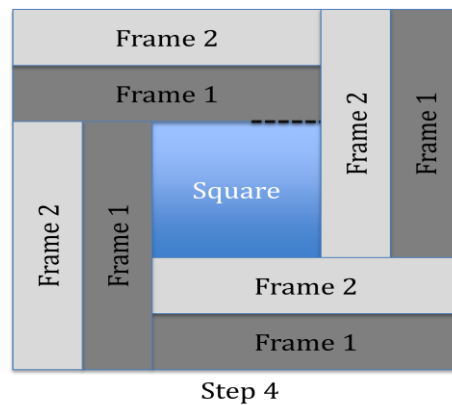
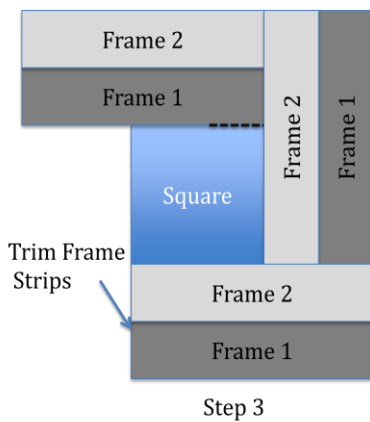
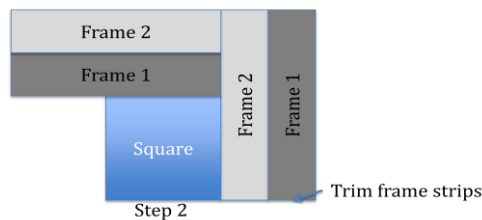
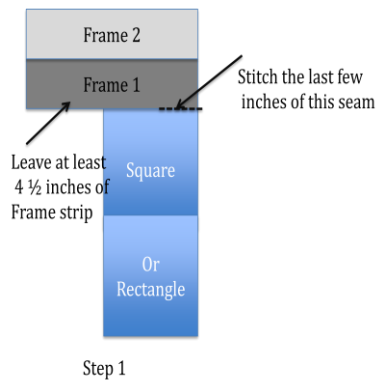
WOF – Width of Fabric (42 inches) – Remove selvage and make a straight cut
 Theme Panel: 19.5 inches
 Frame 1: 30 inches
 Frame 2: 30 inches
 Outer Border: 30 inches
 Binding: 17.5 inches

Cutting

Theme Panel: 3 - WOF by 6½ inches - to make 6 - 6½ inch squares and 3 - 6½ by 18½ rectangles
Frame 1 & 2: 12 - WOF by 2½ inch strips for each
Border (Outer): 6 - WOF by 5 inch strips
Binding: Cut 7 - WOF by 2½ inch strips

Directions

- Using a ¼ inch seam allowance, sew 11 of the Frame 1 and 2 strips together. Press toward Frame 1.
- Make blocks starting with the 6½ inch theme squares and the 18 ½ inch theme rectangles in the centre as follows. Press away from center.



- **NOTE:**
 - Frame 1 is closest to the square/rectangle on 2 sides and Frame 2 is closest to the square/rectangle on the other 2 sides.
 - The orientation for the blocks with the squares as centre or the rectangles as centre is the same.
 - Make sure you have enough long strips for the larger blocks (that is reuse a short strip left over from a previous seam before using a new long strip)
- Sew each row of the blocks together. Row 1 is the 3 squares row 2 is the 3 rectangles and row 3 is the last 3 squares – see overall diagram. Press seams in odd row to the left and even rows to the right. Sew rows of blocks together
- **Border** – For inner border sew a 2½ inch strip of Frame 1 to the top of the quilt and a 2½ inch strip of Frame 2 to the bottom of the quilt (the color of the inner border (frame piece) is opposite to the majority of the color of the row to which it is being attaching). Measure the width of the quilt and cut 2 – 5 inch outer border strips that length, if necessary join the border strip). Sew to top and bottom of quilt. Press toward the border. Sew the remaining 5 inch outer border strips together lengthwise. Measure the length of the quilt and cut 2 border strips that length and sew to the sides of the quilt. Press towards the border
- **Completing** – Press quilt top. Make a sandwich of quilt, batting and backing
- Quilt as desired.
- Attach a VQC (Victoria Quilt's Canada) Bilingual Label to one corner of the back of the quilt.
- Join the binding strips using a diagonal/bias seam for less bulk and press seams open. Press the binding in half wrong sides together. Bind the quilt.
- Gently wash the quilt using unscented products. Trim any loose threads.
