

## Scrappy Squares (5½-inch)

Finished Quilt Size: 50 by 71 inches  
Finished Block Size: 5 inch squares set on point  
11 on point rows plus corner setting triangles  
Total of 94 Squares

### Kit Requirements

2.2 M or 11 Fat Quarters prints  
.5 M light Setting Triangles  
.7 M Border  
.5 M Binding

### Minimum Fabric Yardage

**WOF** – Width of Fabric (42 inches) Remove selvage and make a straight cut  
Blocks: 77 inches of medium & dark print scraps (94 - 5½ by 5½ inches) or 11 FQ (9 from each)  
Setting Blocks – light print: 16¾ inches  
Border: 24 inches  
Binding: 17½ inches

### Cutting

Blocks: 94 – 5½ inch squares from the print scraps

**NOTE:** you can cut 5½ inch strips and sew them together and cross cut into 5½ by 10½ inch pieces

Setting Blocks – Light print:

- Sides - 7 - 8 3/8 inch squares from light print – cut in half diagonally twice to make 28 side-setting triangles – you only need 26 (**NOTE:** the straight of grain will be toward the border, bias is toward the block)
- Corners - 2 - 4½ inch squares from light print – cut in half diagonally to make 4 corner setting triangles

Border: 6 – WOF by 4 inches

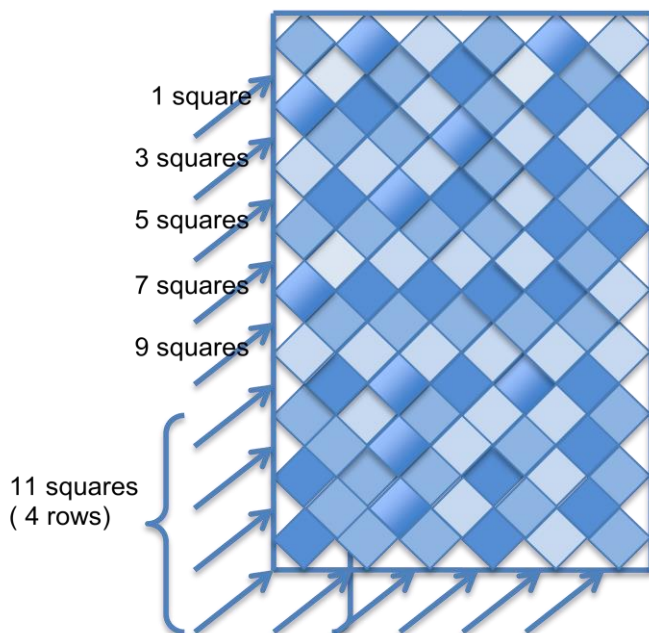
Binding: 7 - WOF by 2½ inches

**NOTE:** the 5½ inch squares are 7 inches on the diagonal

### Directions

Sew the 5½ squares together using a ¼ inch seam allowance as shown into strips of:

- 2 strips of one square with a setting triangle on each end
- 2 strips of 3 squares with a setting side triangle on each end
- 2 strips of 5 squares with a setting triangle on each end
- 2 strips of 7 squares with a setting triangle on each end
- 2 strips of 9 squares with a setting triangle on each end
- 4 strips of 11 squares with a setting triangle on each end



### Assemble the Quilt

- Arrange the strips as shown in the diagram
  - Ensure the setting triangle is oriented correctly as per diagram
  - Press seams in opposite direction for each row so that they nest together when the rows are joined together

- Sewing the rows together.
- **Border** – Measure the width of the quilt and cut 2 border strips that length. Sew to top and bottom of quilt. Press toward the border. Join the remaining 4 border strips together lengthwise. Measure the length of the quilt and cut 2 border strips that length. Sew to the sides of the quilt. Press towards the border
- **Completing** – Press quilt top. Make a sandwich of quilt, batting and backing
- Quilt as desired.
- Attach a VQC (Victoria Quilt's Canada) Bilingual Label to one corner of the back of the quilt.
- Join the binding strips using a diagonal/bias seam for less bulk and press open. Press the binding in half wrong sides together. Bind the quilt.
- Gently wash the quilt using unscented products. Trim any loose threads.
