

## Stitched Scraps

Finished Quilt Size: 50 by 70 inches  
Finished Block Size: 10 by 10 inches  
Arrange blocks 4 by 6 – total of 24 blocks

### Kit Requirements

2.5 M Scraps  
1 M Border  
.5 M Binding

### Minimum Fabric Yardage

**WOF** – Width of Fabric (42 inches) Remove selvage and make a straight cut  
Blocks: 79 inches of scraps  
Border: 33 inches  
Binding: 17½ inches

### Cutting

Cut as follows for each block:

- 4 - 3 by 3 inch squares (total 96)
- 2 - 3 by 5 ½ inches rectangles (total 48)
- 2 - 3 by 10 ½ inches rectangles (total 48)
- **NOTE:** you can cut 3 inch strips and cross cut them into 96 – 3 inch squares, 48 rectangles each 3 by 5½ inches and 48 rectangles each 3 by 10½ inches

Border: 6 – WOF by 5½ inches strips

Binding: 7 WOF by 2½ inch strips

### Directions

- Using a ¼ inch seam allowance, sew the 3-inch squares into a 4-patch
- Sew the 3 by 5½ strip on either side of 4-patch
- Sew 3 by 10½ strips on either side of the block
- As shown in the diagram



Try to have each piece in the block a different fabric – if you want a scrappy quilt

### Assemble the Quilt

- Sew 6 rows of 4 blocks each as shown in the diagram. Press seams in odd rows to the left and even rows to the right. Sew rows of blocks together.
- **Border** – Measure the width of the quilt and cut 2 border strips that length. Sew to top and bottom of the quilt. Press toward the border. Sew remaining border strips together lengthwise. Measure the length of the quilt and cut 2 border strips that length. Sew to the sides of the quilt. Press towards the border.
- **Completing** – press quilt top. Make a sandwich with backing, batting and top

- Quilt as desired
- Attach a VQC (Victoria Quilt's Canada) Bilingual Label to one corner of the back of the quilt.
- Join binding strips using a diagonal/bias seam for less bulk and press open. Press the binding in half wrong sides together. Bind the quilt.
- Gently wash the quilt using unscented products. Trim any loose threads.
