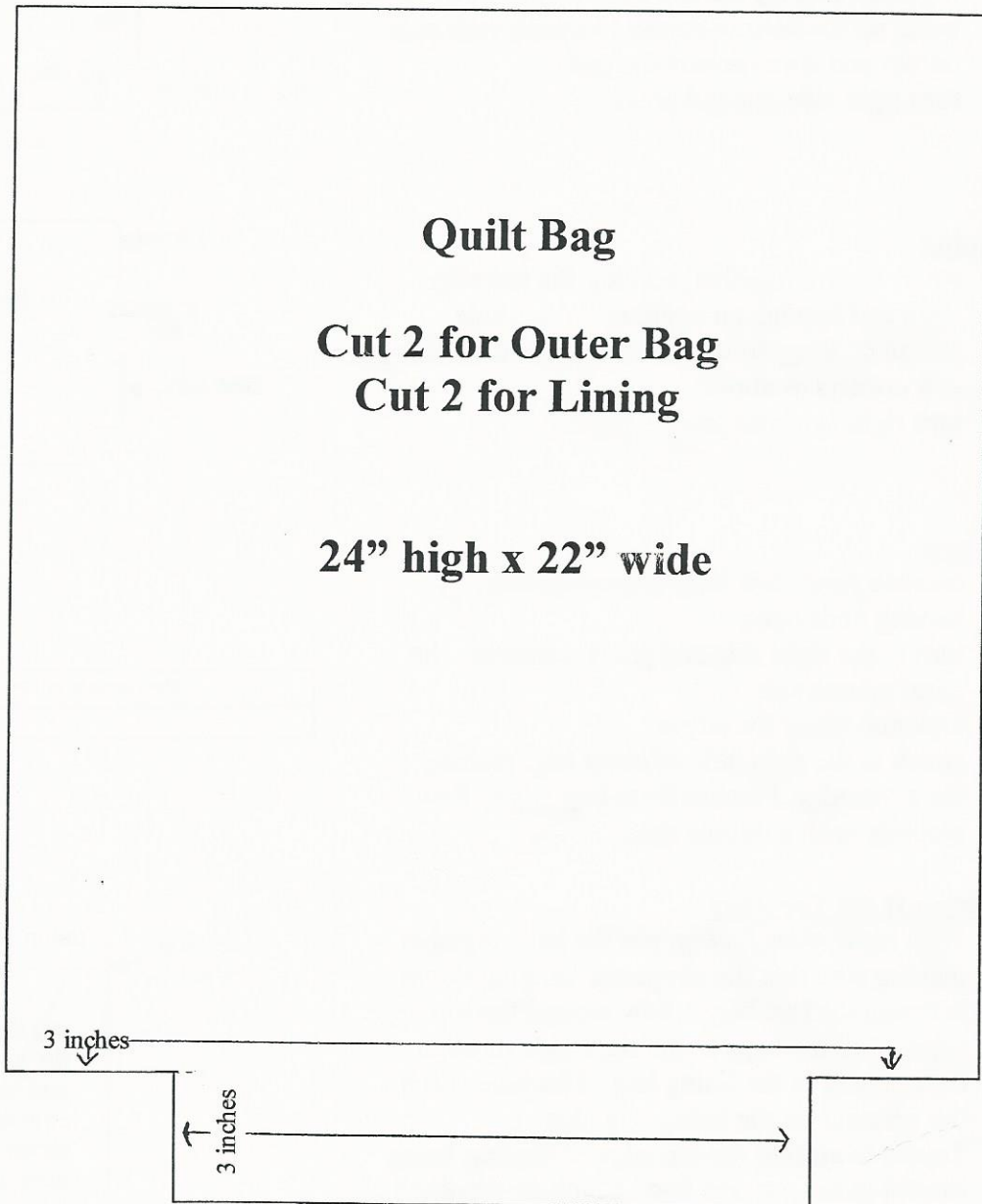


Straps – Cut 2 18” x 4”

Quilt Bag

**Cut 2 for Outer Bag
Cut 2 for Lining**

24” high x 22” wide



PATTERN FOR QUILT BAG

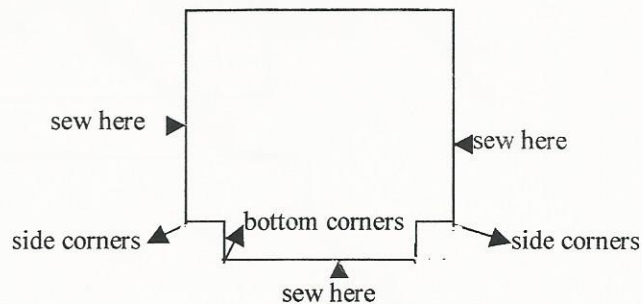
Measurements can be adjusted to fit available fabric
There is about 2” in each direction to play with

PUTTING THE QUILT BAG TOGETHER

NOTE: Outside bag and inside lining are sewn separately, then joined.

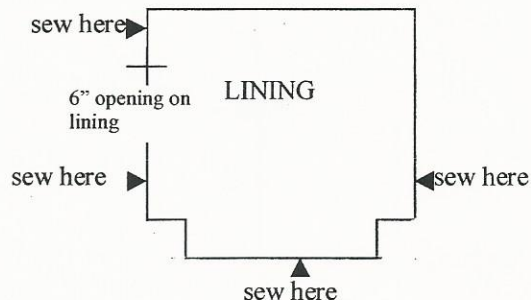
Outside

- using two pre-cut pieces, with right sides facing, pin and stitch the sides and bottom together, leaving the top edge open.
- bring up the bottom corner to match with side corner and stitch across the end.
- turn right side out and press



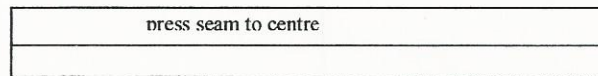
Lining

- stitch 3 sides together, leaving the top edge open and leaving an opening on one side (about 6" long) to turn to the right side
- sew corners as above
- turn right side and press



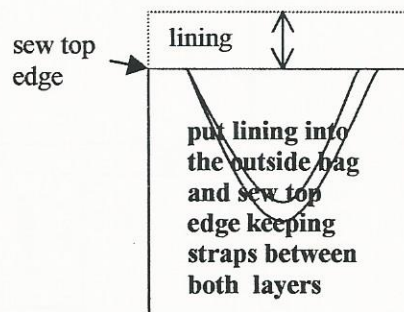
Straps

- on each strap, sew long edges together, leaving ends open
- turn to the right side and press, centering the seam on one side
- topstitch along the edges
- attach to the right side of outer bag, placing the strap edge 7 inches from bag edge. Sew securely with a double stitch.



Putting It All Together

- With *right sides facing*, pin the bags together making sure that the straps are hanging down between the two bags. Sew around the top edge. Pull the bags to the right side through the opening in the lining bag. Machine stitch the opening on the lining bag closed. Topstitch around the top edge of the bag being careful to keep straps free. Stitch-in-the-ditch at the bottom corners to keep the bags together



Optional Pocket

If a quilt square has been provided for a pocket, cut a piece of fabric the same size as square.

- stitch 4 sides together, leaving an opening to turn to the right side
- clip corners, turn right side out and press
- centre and top stitch along two sides and bottom of pocket to outside of bag. It is a good idea to stitch again close to first stitching.
