

Walk About

Finished Quilt Size: 50 by 70 inches
Finished Block Size: 10 by 10 inches
Arrange: 5 by 7 blocks - Total of 35 Blocks

Kit Requirements

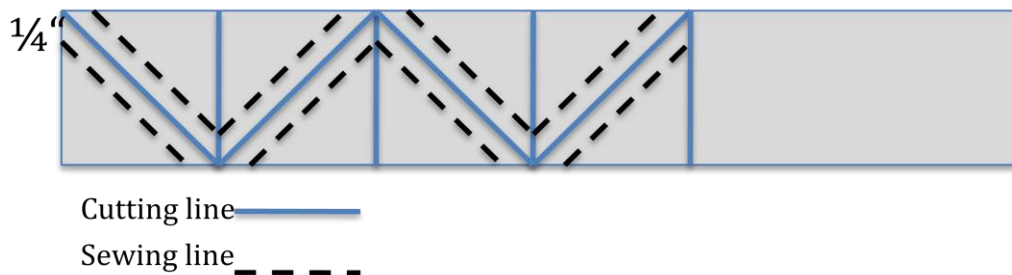
1.5 M Theme **or**
1.1 M & coordinating Fat Quarter
1 M Dark & Contrast each
.5 M Binding

Minimum Fabric Yardage

WOF – Width of Fabric (42 inches) – Remove selvage and make a straight cut
Theme: 52.5 inches or 42 inches and a coordinating Fat Quarter (center block)
Dark & Contrast: - 35¼ inches each
Binding: 17.5 inches

Half Square Triangles (HST) be sure to cut your strips/squares 7/8" wider than you want your finished HST (e.g. for 5" finished square cut at 5 7/8"). Draw a diagonal line (from corner to corner) on the wrong side of one square. Place fabric right sides together. Sew ¼" away from the line on both sides. Cut on the drawn line making 2 HST from one square of each color.

NOTE: You can also use strips for HST. Mark 5 7/8 inch squares (or whatever your measurement is) and draw diagonal lines through the squares in a zigzag fashion. Stitch ¼ inch away from each side of the diagonal lines. Cut apart into squares and cut on the diagonal lines into HST.



Cutting

Theme: 5 WOF by 10½ inches, cross cut into 17 - 10½ inch squares (you only need one square from your last strip)

Or

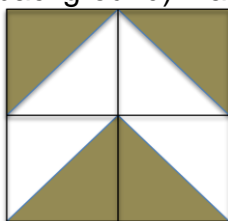
4 WOF by 10½ inches cross cut into 16 - 10½ inch squares and one 10½ inch square from the Fat Quarter for the center

Dark & Contrast: 6 – WOF by 5 7/8 inch strips

Binding: 7 – WOF by 2½ inch strips

Directions

- Make 72 Half Square Triangles from the Dark and Contrast fabrics. See instructions above. Press half the seams toward the Dark and the other half toward the Contrast (for easier joining of the Chevron block)
- Sew 4 of them together to make contrast Chevron (so the dark is like a background) Make 18 blocks.



- Sew alternating chevron and Large Scale prints together as shown in diagram
 - 4 rows with 3 Chevron and 2 Theme blocks and
 - 3 rows with 3 Theme and 2 Chevron
 - Pay particular attention to the direction of the Chevron blocks
- Press seams in odd row to the left and even rows to the right. Sew rows of blocks together
- **Completing** – Press quilt top. Make a sandwich of quilt, batting and backing
- Quilt as desired.
- Attach a VQC (Victoria Quilt's Canada) Bilingual Label to one corner of the back of the quilt.
- Join the binding strips using a diagonal/bias seam for less bulk and press seams open. Press the binding in half wrong sides together. Bind the quilt.
- Gently wash the quilt using unscented products. Trim any loose threads.
